Covid-19 Update: 24/03/2020

The Cornwall Park Trust Board have made further changes following the New Zealand Government announcement yesterday. We are currently at Alert Level 3 and moving to Alert Level 4 on Wednesday 25th March 2020.

Cornwall Park still remains open to the public for you to enjoy, walk your dog on a lead, ride your bike on the road and spend quality time, however the park will be closed to motor vehicles from 8pm Wednesday 25th March 2020. Alternative parking is available on Pūriri Drive and the surrounding areas. Should you enter the park on foot or by bicycle, you need to observe the Ministry of Health and New Zealand Government notices about social distancing and keep at least 2m from other users while in the park. Cornwall Park is a lovely big park, so please take the opportunity to discover new areas.










Cornwall Park is a significantly worse place with cars. Even if they have restricted access.
